

Dave Hill 500 word biography October 2016

Dave Hill is Emeritus Professor of Education Research at Anglia Ruskin University, Chelmsford, England, and Visiting Professor of Education at the Kapodistrian and National University of Athens, Greece.

Dave is a Marxist academic and political activist in different countries, in particular with trade unions and left/ socialist/ Marxist groups in Greece, Turkey, Ireland, Australia and USA as well as England. He has advised the Labour Party in Britain, the OLME teacher trade union in Greece, and regularly works with Egitim Sen, the Education Public Sector Workers Union in Turkey. His academic work focuses on issues of neoliberalism, capitalism, class, 'race', resistance and socialist education/ education for equality; critical pedagogy/ critical education.

He founded in 2003 and chief edits the free online peer-juried journal, the *Journal for Critical Education Policy Studies*, www.jceps.com, a free online, scholarly, peer-juried international journal that has had well over a million downloads since 2003. The journal is also available in print. Previously he co-founded the Hillcole Group of Radical Left Educators, chairing it 1989-2001. Together with Kostas Skordoulis, he co-founded in 2010 the annual ICCE conference (International conference on critical education) and, with Leena Helavaara Robertson and Polina Chrysochou, organised the 6th ICCE conference at Middlesex University in August 2016. He also manages and directs the independent publishing unit, the Institute for Education Policy Studies (www.ieps.org.uk).

He has published 23 books and over a hundred chapters and academic articles. Among his most recent books are:

Dave Hill is a socialist political activist, twice a Labour Parliamentary candidate, when Labour was left-wing, Labour Council Group Leader, elected trade union regional leader in England and long-time trade union branch chair/shop steward. He left the Labour Party in 2006 because of its pro-war, pro-neoliberal/ anti- working class policies, and has recently been a socialist candidate in the 2009 European elections and the 2010 and 2015 UK general elections, for TUSC, the Trade Unionist and Socialist Coalition. He is a member of Momentum, applied to join the Labour Party after Jeremy Corbyn's election as Leader, and is a member of the Labour Party Socialist Network in the UK. His is also affiliated with OKDE-Spartakos, the Greek section of the Fourth International, in Greece.
